Changing Perspectives: Focusing on Strengths and Protective Factors with Adolescents Who Have Sexually Offended

This workshop will begin with an overview of the scientific and practical limitations of current risk prediction tools and approaches, including those developed by the author, and we will discuss some of the exciting, recent research regarding protective factors—i.e., factors that protect against sexual reoffending. Following an outline of the rationale for the development of a new tool and approach, the focus of this workshop will be to introduce participants to the application of the PROFESOR (Protective + Risk Observations For Eliminating Sexual Offense Recidivism).

The PROFESOR is a new, experimental checklist designed to identify and summarize protective and risk factors for adolescents and emerging adults who have offended sexually (i.e., those aged 12 to 25). Whereas most risk assessment tools that are currently in use in the field were intended to predict the future, the PROFESOR is designed to assist with planning interventions that can help individuals to enhance their capacity for sexual and relationship health and, thus, eliminate sexual recidivism.
